

5 of family killed in Odisha road accident

BHUBANESWAR: Five members of a family, including two children were killed in a road accident in Odisha's Bolangir, police said on Wednesday. The accident took place late on Tuesday night near Chhuinbancha square on Sambalpur-Bolangir National Highway-26. While five

died on the spot, two critically injured persons were admitted to Burla Medical College. Atmaj Nayak of Ramjeepada in Bolangir along with six other members of his family were returning home in a car after attending a wedding event in the Agalpur area in the district.

Most of her songs were composed by Shankar-Jaikishan, with Shankar taking special interest in promoting her, at the risk of upsetting diva Lata Mangeshkar. Sharda worked with top singers like Mohammad Rafi and Mukesh, among others, lending her voice to top heroines like Vijayantimala, Sadhana, Saira Bano, Hema Malini, Sharmila Tagore, Mumtaz, Rekha and Helen. But in the '70s, her fadeout began. After Shankar-Jaikishan, there was no one who found her unique voice suitable. She tried her hand at penning lyrics and even composing music. She composed for 'B'-grade movies but hardly any of her compositions made a mark. In 2007, she released an album of Mirza Ghalib ghazals, titled 'Andaaz-e-Bayaan-Aur', which too made no ripples.

WPI at multi-year low

Although the RBI tracks consumer price index (CPI), the decline in wholesale price index (WPI) based inflation rate will be reflected in the retail inflation with a time lag. The deceleration in WPI comes in line with the easing of May retail inflation, which came in at a 25-month low of 4.25 per cent.

Rivals face common foe

Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) Director-General Mrutyunjay Mohapatra told a press conference on Wednesday afternoon that Biparjoy is changing its path and set to move north-eastwards to hit Kutch and Saurashtra, and the neighbouring Pakistan between Mandvi and Karachi on Jakhu port in Gujarat. Mohapatra added that the cyclone had weakened further but it would still make a landfall at 125-135 km an hour with gusts up to 145 to 150 km.

Seven persons are reported to have died in India so far in mishaps caused by the cyclone, including rough seas and wall collapse, while there is no immediate information available of any casualties in Pakistan. Simultaneously, Pakistan's National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) chairman Inam Haider Malik addressed a conference and informed mediapersons that the evacuation of 1 lakh persons would be complete by Thursday, much before the cyclone makes its landfall.

Malik said the cyclone's intensity has increased and has been upgraded from a severe to a very severe emergency, which can inundate low-lying settlements along the coastline in both the countries. Thousands of people inhabiting coastal towns and small islands in Pakistan have on their own left their homes for safer places, and ships and boats have been moved away from the country's coast, which is witnessing high tides and heavy rains.

Ditto in Gujarat, where moderate to heavy rains with strong winds swept the coastal districts of Kutch, Jamnagar, Devbhumi Dwaraka and Porbandar, as well as three other districts in Saurashtra region close to the coast. Meanwhile, The Express Tribune reported that the Balochistan government has declared a state of emergency in the coastal areas of the disputed province.

Believe it or not: Avg property...

Housing prices in the MMR remained largely stable in the first quarter of 2023. At the same time, peripheral micro markets like Panvel, witnessed a nine per cent increase on YoY basis, followed by the western suburbs at 6.4 per cent. Moreover, the region continued to account for the highest share of unsold units amongst the major cities in India. Unsold inventory has been consistently rising in the region for the last few quarters, led by new project launches in the city. "FY 2023 witnessed the highest-ever new launches and sales across major Indian cities in India. The trends will likely continue, the sale and supply will likely grow, and the price rise will be moderate," said Pankaj Kapoor, managing director, Liasies Foras.

Across the eight spots, the average price hike works out to eight per cent. "Given the positive market fundamentals, both end-users and investors can find their sweet spot in this sturdy market. Amidst this upswing, housing prices in India witnessed an eight per cent YoY rise in the first quarter of 2023," said Peesh Jain, managing director (occupier services), Colliers India.

Tot in coma...

His parents were asked to shift their child to KEM hospital for further treatment. "The boy was brought to hospital in an unconscious state with epilepsy, which requires neurosurgery, which is not available at the hospital. The decision to shift him was taken after informing the parents. The resident medical officer deployed in the emergency ward of KEM was informed about the urgent transfer of a patient to their hospital, who required immediate medical treatment. After the paperwork was done, the child was transferred to KEM hospital," said a hospital doctor on condition of anonymity.

Risabh's father, Chandan Mourya, who works as a carpenter in Mumbai for the last three to four years had never thought he would see his child in the intensive care unit of a hospital. Mourya said, for lack of facilities at Bhabha Hospital, they had transferred Rishabh to KEM hospital by 12.30pm. But when they reached the emergency ward, they were not given any bed despite the hospital having been informed about the patient's condition. They had to wait for hours to get admission before Rishabh received treatment.

"We were told that my child would be immediately admitted but when we reached the hospital, it was total chaos as doctors said there were no beds. We were asked to wait despite beds being available. We had to take help from friends in Bhiwandi. It was only after their intervention that my son was admitted to the ICU and treatment was started. It took more than 12 hours for my son to get admission, despite being a priority case," he said.

According to doctors, Rishabh's condition is critical and he is being continuously monitored. However, despite repeated calls, KEM Hospital Dean Dr Sangeeta Rawat was not reachable. Mourya said his son's condition was critical but there was no one to inform him what was going on. "The doctors told me he has been in a coma since yesterday (Tuesday) and I am scared whether or not he will get proper treatment, after all I faced before admitting him," he added.

A senior doctor said it was not the first case where a patient had to wait for hours. The number of patients getting to emergency wards has increased and it was not possible to accommodate everyone,

despite which they had managed to do so, the doctor said. Every family wanted their patient to be seen first, which could not be done, the doctor explained. "But in this case, I don't know how there was a delay, despite prior information of the transfer. The more the child was made to wait, the worse his condition got. The hospital administration should look into the matter," he said.

No let-up in Manipur

Though Aigijang, the new flashpoint, is a Kuki village, but the bodies recovered reportedly belonged to nine Meitei men. The police said they were "local volunteers".

Aigijang lies at the border of Kangpokpi and Imphal East districts. With no let-up in violence over the last several days, many Meitei men have reportedly come to from nearby areas to "defend" the Meitei-dominated parts of this border area.

A PTI report cited said suspected militants, armed with sophisticated weapons, surrounded the villagers in the Khamenlok area late evening and then launched an attack around 1 am. Meanwhile, Shah's visit to Telangana has been postponed in view of the severe cyclonic conditions in the West Coast, state BJP said on Wednesday.

Canada halts deportation

Chance to prove innocence: The development comes days after Fraser assured the former students that they will have an opportunity to prove their innocence and explain how they were taken advantage of. "Innocent students who are the victims of fraud would be given a chance to prove that they were taken advantage of," said Fraser, who added that the Canadian government will provide an appropriate remedy for them. Previously two of the former students, who were set to be deported from Canada, received a stay on their removal orders as many of their peers took to the streets of cities such as Toronto, Brampton, and more to protest against the hearings.

While Karamjeet Kaur saw her removal order on May 29 get a stay for the next 4-6 months, Lovepreet Singh's deportation for June 13 was also deferred until further notice on the same. Why deportation threat: The new announcement will help the remaining former students, who came to Canada between 2017-2020, heave a sigh of relief as many of them maintain that they did not know about their admission letters being fraudulent.

According to the former students, Brijesh Mishra, a Jalandhar-based consultant, signed fake admission letters for them while charging anywhere between Rs 15-20 lakhs.

Though Mishra allegedly told them that they have been admitted to renowned Canadian colleges such as Seneca, Humber, etc, after landing in the country, they were informed that their admissions haven't been confirmed leading them to take admissions to lesser-known, tier-2 institutions. After finishing their academics, the

individuals went on to attain their work permits and eventually continued with their PR process, which is when Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) identified their offer letters to be fake.

While Mishra is on the run, two of his associates have been arrested by the Punjab Police in connection with the matter.

Politicians back students

The alleged scam has also drawn the attention of politicians across Canada and India. While New Democratic Party (NDP) leader, Jagmeet Singh raised a motion in the parliament regarding the matter, Canadian PM Justin Trudeau urged that the government is 'focusing on the culprits and not penalising the students.'

Hyderabad woman...

The brutal attack, which reportedly took place at 10 am on Tuesday, also involved a second woman – a 28-year-old who was taken to hospital with stab injuries. Police officers were called to Neeld Crescent in Wembley, north London, to investigate the reports of a double stabbing. Two female victims were treated at the scene by the emergency services and while one died on the spot.

Indian-Origin teen ...

While the victims are yet to be formally named by the police, local media reports from Nottingham say Grace Kumar is the daughter of a London-based doctor of Indian origin, Dr Sanjoy Kumar. He is being dubbed a "hero" doctor who saved the lives of some teenage stab victims in his local surgery back in 2009. Tributes have been pouring in for Grace, who played for the England under-18s hockey team and was also a cricketer. "We are all deeply saddened by the news of the tragic death of Grace Kumar in Nottingham on Tuesday," England Hockey, the sport's governing body, said in its tribute.

Minor on joy ride...

Akbar died at the spot and a grievously injured Kiran was taken to JJ Hospital, where she succumbed to her injuries.

A police officer disclosed that Akbar was a resident of Nagpada and Kiran was his girlfriend. Tuesday happened to be Akbar's birthday and both of them went out at night to celebrate the moment. The mishap happened when they were returning home after the short-lived revelry.

Akbar resided at Arab Street of Nagpada and did odd jobs. Kiran lived near Shalimar Theatre at Grant Road (East) and worked in a private company. According to the police, the minor had left his house with the car without informing anyone. He happens to be a college student who has just cleared 12th; he is a resident of Parel and his father works in a senior position in a nationalised bank. The 17-year-old used to go for cycling with his friend everyday but on Wednesday morning there was a drizzle; so, he went out for a joy ride with his friend in the car.
