The Bank will support PMC's semi-solid waste management initiatives for a period of 3 years

**Prayagraj, 05 April 2025**: Bank of Baroda (Bank), one of India's leading public sector banks, has joined hands with Prayagraj Municipal Corporation (PMC) as the **"Sustainability Development Partner"** of the civic body for a period of three years. The treated waste will be used in composting, which helps in preventing soil erosion, promoting healthier plant growth, conservation of water, reducing waste, improving soil health, wetland reclamation and combating climate change.

Additionally, Bank of Baroda has also collaborated with Prayagraj Municipal Corporation as the "Green Partner" for the landmark *Daak Ghar Chauraha* installation located near the Post Office at Civil Lines in Prayagraj. Serving as a tribute to postal workers, the waste-to-wonder 10 foot high statue of a postman is made entirely of sustainable materials.
